





Street Art at Teufelsberg

WELCOME TO TEUFELSBURG




Welcome to Teufelsberg!

Teufelsberg, a 120-meter-high non-natural hill in Berlin, was created from the rubble of World War II. The hill was built between 1950 and 1972 on the remains of the unfinished Military-Technical Faculty. Known for the former Allied listening station that operated from 1963 to 1994 during the Cold War, with its radar domes still dominating the skyline today, Teufelsberg is now a popular tourist destination. Enjoy the stunning views over Berlin and explore the rich history of this unique site.
